

## Concerning Virtual School Registration

Dear Parents and Students,

Students benefit most when they are in classrooms for “in-person” learning where they can listen to and learn from other students and their teachers. However, there are times when scheduling conflicts can be solved using the New Westminster Virtual School.

If a student is granted permission to use the virtual school, we kindly request that parents and students review and agree to the following points:

- Personal discipline, including time management and commitment, is required to successfully complete a virtual school course.
- In place of the in-person class time, students agree to work on their virtual school class. For example, if the open time due to not having an in-person class is in B Block (9:25 to 10:45), students must use this time every day to work on their virtual school course in a quiet location in the school. Students should avoid the distractions of friends and mobile devices.
- Students are responsible for submitting all assignments and completing in-person and online exams by the deadline outlined by the teacher.
- The use of Artificial Intelligence, plagiarism, and other forms of cheating will result in the student being removed from the Virtual School. A “withdrawal” will be noted on the Ministry of Education transcript.
- Students can visit the virtual school classroom in room 3000 for assistance.
